

Ten tips for greener fleet management

- 1 Promote the use of low polluters - via your allocation policy, promote cars with low CO2 emission levels, which will reduce employee BIK tax costs
- 2 Evaluate the use of alternatively fuelled cars - to see where they may be beneficial to your fleet
- 3 Ensure vehicles are properly maintained - poorly maintained vehicles have higher fuel consumption and toxic emission levels
- 4 Record and analyse business mileage patterns - this will allow you to manage travel better, and identify opportunities to reduce mileage
- 5 Record and analyse vehicle fuel consumption by driver - to identify areas of high and low fuel efficiency

- 6 Consider driver training to promote more economical and (safer) driving
- 7 Ensure travel remuneration policies are environmentally sensitive - do not have business mileage reimbursement rates that encourage drivers to cover excessive miles
- 8 Provide journey planning advice - through providing web access to sites that give street maps and route planners and alternatives to using the car
- 9 Consider satellite navigation and telematics as a means of avoiding congestion and optimising journey routes
- 10 Review facilities for teleconferencing / video conferencing which will offer alternatives to business travel
